


Why Veneers Are a Great Choice for Adults with Small Teeth?

Do Dental Veneers Make Your Teeth Bigger?

In fact, they can actually make them appear smaller if they are not the right size and shape for your teeth. If you're unhappy with the size of your teeth, veneers might be right for you. How Veneers Work

Veneers are attached to the front surface of your teeth using a strong bonding agent. The entire procedure usually takes two visits to the dentist. During the first visit, the dentist will take an impression of your teeth and send it off to a dental laboratory where the veneers will be made.

In the meantime, the dentist will fit you with temporary veneers. Once the permanent veneers are ready (usually within 2-4 weeks), you'll return to the dentist for a second appointment during which the temporary veneers will be removed and the permanent veneers will be attached using a bonding agent.

Veneers are made of porcelain or composite resin material. Porcelain veneers are more stain resistant than composite veneers and they often last longer (10-15 years vs. 5-7 years for composite). However, they also tend to be more expensive than composite veneer procedures.
